Introduction

The Relationship Report for two individuals applies to any type of relationship. It focuses on the relationship itself, rather than on the individuals who make it up. First a composite chart (mid-point chart) is created. The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together in relationship. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity.

In the following report, each planetary placement and aspect is examined to reveal the basic qualities of your relationship, with the most important factors described first. Please keep in mind that these descriptions are not meant to put limitations on the relationship, but merely to describe its inherent tendencies. Challenging aspects can become the greatest strength of a relationship if you can both learn how to successfully navigate those issues, with good communication between you playing a vital role. For definitions of astrological terms, please refer to the glossary at the end of this report.

Chart Patterns

Seesaw

You have the planetary pattern called the 'seesaw' type. With your planets divided into two distinct groups, you are very balanced in your outlook, always being aware of both sides of an issue, always able to compromise between opposing points of view. In this way you are quite similar to a Libra personality.

Composite Venus in Libra (25° Lib 49') Composite Venus in the First House

The Sole Dispositor helps form your core personality, it ultimately rules all the other planets of your

chart:

The placement of Venus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared emotional focus and love and where mutual enjoyment and benefit lies.

Venus in the First House (or sign) your relationship has a strong emotional support with plenty of warmth between you. One important focus of this connection is the good feeling that you share. You are comfortable with each other and naturally affectionate. In a romantic relationship, this is a very good placement and ensures that abiding feelings of love will be present and that whatever disagreements may arise, they will be ameliorated by a solid foundation of mutual admiration between you. You may only have to be careful not to take this relationship for granted. As a partnership you appear charming and gracious, and may be known by others as a cheerful, generous and diplomatic pairing. If you go into business with each other, public relations will be a strong suit of whatever joint venture you decide to tackle. You will generally speaking have much success with financial matters and an easy harmony of interaction that makes for an excellent partnership in whatever form it takes.

With composite Venus in Libra (or the seventh house) your relationship has a strong emotional support with plenty of warmth between you. Your relationship is founded upon good will and mutual admiration, and others around you are aware of the appeal that you have for each other. As a partnership you appear charming and gracious, and may be known by others as a cheerful and generous pairing. You will generally speaking have success with financial matters. In a romantic relationship, this is a very good placement and ensures a high degree of affection and caring between you. You are each happy to be in relationship, it matters to you, and because you share these values, this particular one feels like a continuing blessing. Together you are gentle and kind with each other and possess refined aesthetic and artistic sensibilities, and a keen sense of color. If you go into business, public relations will be a strong suit of whatever ventures you decide to tackle. You have the joint capacity to excel in many professions, including legal work and diplomacy.

Yod, focal planet Uranus

You have a Yod planetary aspect pattern in your chart, also known as the 'finger of God'. This pattern consists of two different planets forming inconjunct aspects of 150° to a third, or focal, point. Usually there will be a marked emphasis on the area of life represented by this focal point, which may be one planet, or two or more in conjunction. You may have physical or psychological problems associated with the expression of the energies of the focal planet or planets, creating a subtle form of tension in your life. The key is adjustment. Your lesson is to transform the expression of these energies along more positive lines.

Uranus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter unusual and unexpected circumstances and where the relationship benefits from lack of structure.

Uranus in the First House (or sign) gives your relationship an original and eccentric nature. Working together, you move from a place of powerful and intuitive vision, perhaps more so than working separately. Change and variety excite you as a partnership and may in fact be essential. Your mutability and habit of constantly changing can frustrate or confuse those around you, but it represents a fresh approach and in the end they may thank you for it. In a romantic connection, you two are likely to be known as a couple for your nonconformity. This energy you share can be insensitive to others' needs, and you can appear to be cold at times, or you may seem to be more

excited by ideas than by each other. You may each feel the need to constantly assert your independence, so that in this relationship you need space from each other as well as closeness, and it may prove difficult to balance these opposing factors. When you can accept your mutual desire for freedom as an important part of the relationship equation, you go a long way toward solving this basic dilemma. Your relationship celebrates free spiritedness, courage and pioneering, and your mission on behalf of yourselves as well as the surrounding collective involves bringing innovative ideas into being along with new ways of acting in the world.

Composite Uranus in Libra (or the seventh house) gives your relationship a quality of independent and unique expression. Your relationship may itself be your very own shared masterpiece, stunningly unabashed in its refusal to suffer the consequences of convention. You two likely feel freer and more alive when you are together than when you are apart from each other. In a romantic setting, your level of shared affection may dwindle and surge. You need to bring new approaches to the relationship that can help to resolve these difficulties, and perhaps may experiment with an unconventional union where you take space from each other as well as remain together. You benefit from learning not to make promises to each other that you can't keep. You share an idealistic and philosophical outlook, and a restless interest in new forms of stimulation. Together, you break new ground. Your lesson in this partnership may be to transform the partnership energy into a new mode of being that can serve your individual interests and enliven and invigorate each other in the bargain.

Important Features

Composite Mars in Aquarius (25° Aqu 22')

Composite Mars in the Fifth House

The placement of Mars in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared activity in pursuit of partnership goals, and where ego needs may be identified.

Mars in the Fifth House (or sign) brings an energetic and passionate drive to your relationship. You two are likely to be physically active, especially around each other. As a partnership, you may move in a dramatic, ambitious and proud way. You will also likely enjoy recreational activity together. You each have tremendous vitality and courage in the context of this relationship, especially when it comes to the realization of your romantic dreams. It is important that you find a physical outlet for all the energy you bring out in each other, and you thrive in a romantic context on the powerful sexual connection that you likely share. To each other you possess an innate charm and animal magnetism that is central to the way that you connect. As a partnership you well know how to put your best foot forward, and how to bring others along with you toward your goals. You benefit when you can tap into the innate leadership that accompanies this placement, and practice effective delegating, between you or with others.

Composite Mars in Aquarius (or the eleventh house) brings out an idealistic, socially oriented and multidimensional drive in your relationship. This placement can take out the rough edges that each of you may individually harbor and bring you together in a way that benefits both the partnership and the greater world that surrounds you. You two tend to co-create in an enterprising and ambitious way and make classic teammates working together toward socially life-enhancing goals. In a romantic relationship, you may need to become aware of the way you direct your shared activity, giving priority time to your personal issues as well as planetary goals, so that your

partnership rests on a sturdy foundation. You are likely to be friends as well as lovers, which enhances your bond with each other although it may dim your passion. Together you easily tolerate each other's differences and support each other's goals so that in the best of your connection with each other, you move to the clear beat of the same drummer.

Composite Moon in Pisces (2° Pis 57' 28") **Composite Moon in the Fifth House**

The placement of the composite Moon defines the core emotional focus of your relationship. It indicates the most sensitive area between you.

The composite Moon in Leo symbolizes a relationship that needs a strong outlet for the creative expression of emotion. Your relationship tends to bring out affectionate and warm qualities in both of you, with a mutual inclination toward the dramatic. It is likely that you two share a good sense of humor, and a basic fondness for people. Regardless of your individual inclination, together you tend to be highly aware of those around you, and those around you are usually very aware of you as well. In a romantic relationship, you make a dramatic couple, with an instantaneous emotional presence when you walk into a room. Because of this, you may find you want to check in with each other from time to time to make sure you are both on the same page with regard to the group situation. You may find you have a joint interest in animals and children, especially your own children. In fact, the relationship may exude a child-like air in itself, and this is part of its charm. You may find that this relationship has, in addition to its dramatic side, a strong desire for security. Together, you are likely to react with enthusiasm to events. It pays when you can be as aware as possible of the urge you each may have to assume yourselves to be an authority, and when you make time to take the energy that you so easily magnetize and give it back to each other and to those around you.

The composite Moon in Pisces symbolizes a relationship that needs a great deal of sensitivity and compassion to provide a sense of emotional security. Your relationship tends to exhibit a sweet and gentle nature. It brings out a visionary and poetic sentiment, and you two generally are very attuned to spiritual values. You tend to be compassionate and empathetic, and even psychic, with each other and as a partnership with those around you. In a romantic context, your relationship finds itself quite at home in the realms of dreams, fantasies, and visioning. In spite of your individual approaches to life, together you tend to react to the cruelties and unkindness of the world through sensitivity, withdrawal and perhaps escape. It is very important that as you merge together, you share your feelings honestly with each other, thereby remaining true to yourselves, and to the process of getting in touch with your inner worlds. As a partnership, you have great sympathy for the downtrodden and disadvantaged. You may experience some suffering together, through your emotions, especially if your needs are not being met. Composite Saturn in Taurus (3° Tau 16") **Composite Saturn in the Eighth House**

Saturn in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter limitations and build long-lasting success through trials of accomplishment.

Saturn in the Eighth House (or sign) symbolizes an intense relationship that evokes a profound emotional experience between you. There may be a blockage, or a deepening of concentration in your feelings when together so that many and complex emotions are generated between you. You

will likely feel the undercurrent of powerful feelings in connection with your partner, but these may be only partly available to your conscious awareness without doing some work and digging down to try to understand them better. This relationship tends to trigger and thus help you to understand power-oriented and possessive qualities in each of you. In a romantic relationship, you may find that some important level of intimacy is consistently blocked. This can be frustrating, and this placement is in fact a difficult one for romance. If you learn to trust your partner and open up to the process, this relationship can provide each of you with an opportunity heal fears surrounding the issue of emotional closeness and sexuality. One of the main lessons of this relationship may in fact be to learn to master and bring to consciousness these hidden drives within each of you, transforming this energy into a sustaining healing power for yourselves and those around you.

Composite Saturn in Taurus (or the second house) brings out in this relationship a deepening focus on security issues and the material aspects of life. There may be an overemphasis on the material as well as a feeling of blockage there. If you deal with joint finances, you may each feel limitation and eventual bonding around this subject matter. In a romantic relationship, your shared focus on your financial picture makes for a difficult but sustaining road to travel. Eventually a livable and workable solution will emerge. Along the way, it helps to lighten up. As a partnership, you may be drawn to managing investments for others. Your focus and mutual interest makes for an achievement orientation in this area. You also may transition from a superficial idea of the value of possessions to a deeper one based on true utility. This relationship could also bring up issues around self-worth. One of the main lessons in this relationship for each of you is to discover your individual true inner worth, in terms of character, high standards, and service to others. Composite Neptune in Scorpio (28° Sco 34') **Composite Neptune in the Second House**

Neptune in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter idealization and nebulous spiritual feelings that will lead you to self-discovery.

Neptune in the Second House (or sign) brings a kind and charming quality to your relationship, with a shared sensuous nature and artistic sensibility. You are likely to possess jointly a love of music, painting and poetry. You may have much in common in your values, although this can also be a source of confusion or self-deception. Contributing to this potential for deception is your strong sense of idealism around values and resources, or the material world in general. You may not always have a clear picture of what values you share, and it helps to discuss this with each other and try to define them. In a romantic relationship, you may find that an almost psychic sensitivity between you, so that you are constantly aware of what the other is feeling. There may also be mistaken beliefs or deceptive circumstances around the issue of your shared finances. This placement does not encourage realistic thinking about finances and thus may work better in personal relationships than business ones. In any type of relationship, you benefit from curbing a mutual tendency toward excessive consumption or a lack of awareness around investments. You also benefit when you pursue a deeper grounding in your understanding of the material world and make reality checks a regular part of your partnership experience.

Composite Neptune in Scorpio (or the eight house) brings out great personal and spiritual magnetism in each of you as a result of your association. You share a subtle intuition and an unusually clear ability to see into each other's depths, although there may also be a tendency to see each other somewhat through rose-colored glasses. Shared finances may also be subject to a form of idealism or even illusion. You may become more interested in otherworldly affairs, such as

psychic matters or occult studies, than the everyday , or find that you share a love of sensuality and luxury together. With this relationship also, you may experience confusion over the power and/or sexual dynamics that come up between you. It may benefit you to put some extra attention into thinking and feeling through these sensitive issues . A process of spiritual transformation may take place in each of you as the relationship matures. You benefit from applying greater clarity to your shared values and to your intimate connection .

Sun, Moon, Rising Sign Features

Libra Rising

The composite Rising Sign is the image that this partnership presents to others and characterizes the nature of the relationship.

Relationships with composite Libra rising exude a gracious, attractive and unbiased air. You mutually seek harmony and beauty in your surroundings. Libra is the sign of balance and strives for harmony between polarizations. Your relationship brings out in each of you an attitude that the natural mode of living is in relationship with others, which makes this a great placement for a powerful feeling of shared commitment between you. Your ruling planet is Venus, and you are likely known as a partnership for your good taste, elegance and charm. An excellent outlet for your love of beauty is in artistic pursuits of all kinds. In a romantic context, good connections with others outside of your relationship are quite important to you, as are issues of social justice. You function more smoothly when you remember to honor the beauty as well as the practical concerns of your shared living space. You two will go out of your way to avoid a quarrel, but you may have a hard time making concrete decisions together. As a partnership, you excel in shared activity that leads to better and more harmonious connections between people in your sphere of influence. You benefit from strengthening your will to act in favor of your higher purpose, which lies ultimately in dedicating yourself and your partnership to fair-minded support for all of humanity.

Composite Mercury in strong opposition (within 1.3 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between Composite Mercury and Ascendant signifies a relationship that is intellectually sharing. As a partnership you highly value mental pursuits and clear messages. You are rather fond of talking with each other, and your clear communication is a tremendous asset, especially in any form of romantic interaction, since it allows you to keep current with one another. As a partnership, you are quick-witted and glib, and you may turn to writing or public speaking as a way to share your enthusiasm for your ideas. You enjoy exchanging information with each other, and forging communicative bridges with others as well, although you may sometimes have trouble hearing opposing viewpoints to your own. Your logical abilities as a team are excellent. Together you have your own way of looking at things, and you may inspire each other toward a truly visionary outlook.

Composite Uranus in strong conjunction (within 0.2 degrees) with Ascendant

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction between Composite Uranus and Ascendant signifies an eclectic and exciting relationship, but one perhaps also subject to a large degree of variability and even instability. Within this relationship, you have a cosmic connection to a level of intuition far beyond the confines of the physical plane. As a partnership you are original and independent thinkers with active, scientific minds, futuristic in outlook, and you are capable together of bringing new ideas into being. The two of you function in unique ways together, and stimulate each other's thought process. As members of an unusual and perhaps even eccentric partnership, you are rebellious both with respect to the norms of society and with each other, so that you will undoubtedly have to learn to take the bitter with the sweet. Over time you need to decide what you want to get out of the relationship and adjust expectations to match what is actually available. In a business or friendship connection there will be plenty of good ideas floating around, and you will be constantly amused and challenged by the next horizon of what you are attempting to achieve together. However in a love relationship there will necessarily be some major adjustments that you will have to make. Composite Chiron in strong opposition (within 1.4 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between Composite Chiron and Ascendant signifies a relationship with a great deal of healing potential. One or both of you are likely to experience painful realizations through the agency of this relationship that will enable you to recognize and eventually heal important issues that you face. There may be difficulties that come up between you for greater understanding and eventual acceptance and healing, and you will also encounter sympathy from your partner for your own process, enabling you to move forward into wholeness more fully. Chiron is called "the wounded healer" because it represents the archetype of imperfection and loss which when integrated leads to compassion and understanding of your own and others' suffering. In the past, one or both of you have probably experienced pain and frustration related to your self-concept, or there could have been trauma in your early years concerning parental protection which may have been withdrawn too suddenly or misapplied, or perhaps similar issues that arose with peers. These types of early traumas often lie buried behind walls of denial, and only when they are accepted and brought to conscious awareness can true healing begin to take place. There are long-buried issues that may come up for you with this particular partner where you can make enormous progress as you work through them realistically and honestly. Composite Moon in inconjunct (within 7.7 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

This aspect between the Composite Moon and Ascendant signifies a nurturing and protective relationship. As a partnership you are subtle in your actions, rather than direct, and while you are likely to reflect the moods of those around you, you have a sense of a shared emotional commitment that is very strong. You have possibly come together around issues of security and your home and family, for these are important to both of you. Others see the connection between you, since when you are together you show your emotions readily. Whether you find yourselves a romantic relationship or a friendship, you tend to act from an almost instinctual basis, and are truly protective of one another. Since you feel so cared for, there is a tendency for individuality and consciousness to get lost in the shuffle, and you benefit from shedding the light of conscious reason on your habitual patterns, and working toward greater focus on your individual goals.

Composite Saturn in inconjunct (within 3.6 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

This aspect between Composite Saturn and Ascendant signifies a responsible relationship, but with perhaps some serious limitations to contend with. As a partnership, you are very aware of the ties that bind you together, and you also may feel stifled by them at times. You have some difficulties to deal with in sustaining the relationship, but working through difficulties gives your connection with each other a strength that it might not otherwise possess. On the plus side there is likely to be an achievement orientation to your partnership that can take you far toward established goals, as long as you can mutually agree on what those are.

Composite Sun in Pisces (19° Pis 38' 31") Composite Sun in the Sixth House

The placement of the composite Sun defines the core identity of your relationship, and the place where it finds its greatest vitality. It gives you a sense of the predominant flavor of the relationship.

With the Composite Sun in Virgo, this relationship centers on its shared service to others, and in the gathering of the fruits of the material world, as symbolized by the harvest. Regardless of how either of you works alone, you will tend to have a reputation for duty and efficiency when together. You may also find that this relationship lends itself well to organizing and attention to detail. This is the best Sun placement that there is for entering into contracts of any kind, either personal or professional. You will have as your overriding goal an ideal of service to the larger whole. In a romantic relationship, you can temper a tendency toward being critical or overly dutiful with regular ventures into the world of abundance and sensuality that your shared partnership energy also offers. You may find that your shared interests are wide ranging, and that you often get into interesting, analytical conversations with each other and those around you. Your detail orientation also makes you an excellent team as co-workers together. It benefits you to always keep an eye on the big picture, even as you concentrate on each step of the micro.

With the Composite Sun in Pisces, your relationship is likely to center on your shared experience of subtle emotions and secret mystical depths. As a partnership you two are dreamy and full of imagination, and easily influenced by everything around you. This relationship exudes a friendly and likable air, yet you can also be very moody and introspective together and not entirely at home in the world. In a romantic relationship, you may be prone as a duo to fantasy, or to escape together into a world of your own, perhaps without knowing why or where you are really heading. Luckily, with this placement, you two have an enhanced ability to let go of knowing and to simply

trust each moment as it arises. At its best, this relationship is a stronghold for the intuitive way of life and a refuge of compassion, offering to those it carries it a high degree of unconditional love and universal understanding. You may also find that regardless of your individual aptitudes, together you share an artistic temperament that you can use to express deep emotion to each other or in the world. This relationship can be a place of strength and refuge when necessary, though you may often have a hard time figuring out just where this sturdy ship is headed.

Composite Sun in opposition (within 0.2 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between composite Sun and Pluto brings out the power drive in your relationship and signifies a powerful intensity of connection between you. This relationship is likely to change your whole life. There is an almost life and death intensity within the very basic energy of your relationship. As a partnership, you tend to be willful with a natural inclination to play with power, inside the relationship or outside of it. There could be in power struggles, or a compulsion toward self-assertion or self-aggrandizement. There may be underlying feelings of insecurity leading to ego-oriented behavior that shows up between you. As you become more conscious of these dynamics you have the potential to heal them, so that exploring these feelings can be incredibly rewarding for you both. In a romantic relationship, you two may explore the power dynamic through your sexuality. This aspect can also manifest as a powerful urge to join resources and contribute something that will transform the world around you. You have a special penchant for championing underdogs and justice and strong urge for self-transformation. Any way you play it out, your relationship tends to undergo many cycles in its life. In a business partnership, you tend to drive hard, and can work single-mindedly as a team to pursue joint goals and to establish your place in the market. Whatever the basis for this relationship, when you two learn to train your considerable energy on conscious transformation, your relationship can become a focal point for the evolution of society itself.

Composite Moon in strong sextile (within 0.5 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

With this aspect between composite Moon and Saturn, your relationship has a responsible, centered and hard-working basis that also might be experienced as a blockage of emotional connection between you. With this aspect, you may provide each other with the right blend of encouragement and stability to make each of your own lives happen. Initially this relationship may bring out a caution or reserve in your make-up, along with a sound emphasis on the practicalities of life. Over time, however, this same energy will tend to provide you both with a stable and enduring emotional bond. In a romantic relationship, it benefits you to consciously work through any sense of rigidity, putting extra effort into the enthusiastic mining of your feelings. Together, you may be extremely sensitive and able to help each other recover from a strict upbringing. This relationship may be a place where you get to take a good look back at your parental figures, especially your mother, who you might have experienced as rejecting or uncaring. The lesson for you here is to take advantage of each other and the relationship to begin to understand and value the true roots of your being more fully and deeply, leading to a better sense of security and greater self-acceptance. You may reflect for each other problems you both experienced with the parental care and guidance received as children. You win when you learn to discover, accept and integrate

the world of emotions, practice expressing your love and appreciation for each other on a regular basis, and then back up your words with actions. Repeat as necessary.

Composite Moon in semi-sextile (within 8.9 degrees) with Mercury

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

This aspect between composite Moon and Mercury brings a verbally expressive and creative quality to your relationship, and also may indicate that the thinking and feeling functions between you have a tendency to clash at times. You two have a gift for expression, both with each other and as a partnership in your dealings with the larger world. Your powerful thinking and fertile imagination lend a witty and entertaining twist to your joint expression, and you share a knack for putting your ideas into words. There is a creative tension to the verbal and emotional realities of your relationship that can be a force for powerful expression, as long as you can find necessary common ground in your shared desire for love, understanding and acceptance between you. The key here is to stay on top of difficulties each time they arise, and to be careful to take responsibility for your own issues.

Composite Moon in inconjunct (within 8.7 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

With this aspect between composite Moon and Uranus, your relationship has an eccentric and unique home base. Your connection is likely to be an unusual one, with a strong intuitive link between you. Things are never dull, although the resulting emotional instability can represent a challenge if one of you attempts to stay within the bounds of a more conservative approach. You two are likely to have changeable emotions, and may develop a reputation for being unpredictable. In a romantic context, your relationship can give rise to feelings of insecurity at times, possibly because it will evoke memories of disruption from your early home lives. You benefit when you learn to balance your joint need for security with your individual urges for freedom and experimentation. You benefit when you take advantage of what this relationship brings, learn to trust in its ebb and flow, and balance your need for security with your urge for freedom and experimentation.

Composite Moon in square (within 0.5 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

With this aspect between composite Moon and Neptune, your relationship has a powerful emotional basis stemming from a high degree of sensitivity between you. You tend to be very focused on your joint ideals: your ideal environment, your ideal romantic circumstances, perhaps without ever finding the perfect reality. Together you possess an ethereal quality, noticeable to others, and a strong imagination with a propensity for withdrawing from the world from time to time into internal fantasies of your own making. You may also share powerful psychic abilities. You are likely to be hyper-aware of the vulnerability that mutually arises between you, bordering at times on self-sacrifice. Together you tend to sacrifice yourselves for each other, or for the good of others,

so that you may need to be careful not to deceive yourselves about what is going on between and around you or to forget to take care of the practicalities of life on this planet. With Neptune strongly placed like this, it benefits you to look for opportunities to turn deception and confusion into clarity. Are you clear on your addictions and how to work with them? Are you willing to be yourselves and not just play out the other person's fantasy? Are you honest about how you feel about each other moment to moment, and are you honest with yourselves? Once you clear the potential fog between you, your relationship has the strong potential to be a spiritual light unto others.

Composite Moon in semi-sextile (within 9.4 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

This aspect in your composite chart symbolizes a relationship in which there is difficulty with the feminine and nurturing side of life, and also great potential for healing these areas as you work together. Of course the important early model for the feminine is mother, and it is likely that one or both of you experienced some degree of painful episodes there. If there were such traumas in your early relationship with your own mother or significant female parental figure, in the course of this relationship these may be helped toward resolution. In a marriage partnership, there may also be issues to be healed with your children, and the mothering and nurturing that they require. Role models may also come into play here, as you expand your understanding of who you really are in the context of this relationship. Issues with mother are of course endemic in both modern and ancient culture, as typified in mythology. Perhaps you had a close relationship, but yet your needs were somehow not met, resulting in unconscious resentments which only surfaced later in your adult life. Or there may have been emotional or physical abuse. These experiences are so painful that they are often suppressed from consciousness, and buried deep in the psyche. It is important as you progress through life to move past the resentment caused by early wounding into a more conscious and compassionate reconciliation with the walled off parts of your own nature. In order to make progress here, deep psychological process of some variety is strongly indicated, perhaps through therapy, and the issues that come up in close interpersonal relationship often represent a catalyst and provide guideposts for constructive change. Of course it does take work. If you shrink from the task, you may take heart in the fact that these issues will remain, and eventually you will find the way to deal with them. The effort is enormous, but the rewards are just as great. Once you have begun to make conscious the pain and alienation surrounding events from the long buried past, through the agency of this relationship, you can begin to truly be of help others as well as yourselves.

Composite Moon in trine (within 5.7 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

With this aspect between composite Moon and the Midheaven, your relationship has a strong emotional basis with the possibility of a domestic or parenting focus. You have a very soft appeal to each other, in friendship or a romantic connection. If the latter, this is one of the best indications for a shared vision of living together and starting a family. The Moon here indicates that the mothering and feminine side of each of you is a strong part of your relationship equation and that you have commonly held goals there. The sexual chemistry between you may not sizzle, but it is steady and sweet, and your union definitely percolates through your lives in many ways to enrich you both. This makes for a very nurturing relationship in general. You will be prone to take care of each other through the course of time, and of others around you that you connect with as a

partnership. You may work together to develop a vehicle for your caring and socially oriented values such as a plan to feed large groups of people. In any case you will be supportive of such values as may be in the process of emerging on the world scene.

Composite Venus in strong trine (within 2.8 degrees) with Mars

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives a warmly affectionate and lively relationship with a sense of self-assurance and the means to fulfill a strong, shared passion. Regardless of the kind of relationship you two share, this aspect indicates a classically high level of chemistry. There is likely to be a good balance between you of individual and shared goals. As a partnership you may find that the complementary balance of give and take between you makes for a strong connection. You may together possess a lively appreciation for the arts, especially singing and dancing, or other musical forms. You possess an innate kindness and demonstrate a love for your fellow beings on the planet that makes you well liked and well trusted by those around you.

Composite Venus in semi-sextile (within 2.8 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

With this aspect between composite Venus and Pluto, your relationship has a magnetic quality and a passionate intensity for shared interests and a shared focus on forming a close emotional attachment with each other. You may experience challenge in marriage and romantic partnership, and yet also gain great rewards in terms of healing your mutual issues of closeness and dependency. Your intense feelings for each other can lead to a harmonious blending of your energies, lending a powerful faith to your joint activity. With wisdom and love, you can transform any difficult issues that you encounter with each other into a growing and conscious act of sharing.

Other Natal Planets

Composite Mercury in Aries (4° Ari 13') Composite Mercury in the Seventh House

Mercury in the composite chart reveals the quality of the communication process in your relationship, and an area of your shared experience where intellectual compatibility is to be found.

Composite Mercury in Libra brings a positive mental attitude to your relationship, with a good sense of graceful communication. You two tend to be diplomatic with each other and with those around you, and are often quite aware of the effect that your words will have on others. You have terrific judgment and sensitivity most days, with an occasional propensity to lapse to the other extreme once in a while. When together, you tend to express your ideas with balance and fairness to all sides of an issue. Your joint awareness of differing points of view can however make it difficult for you to come to a decision as a partnership. Your relationship brings out a highly developed sense of artistry between you, with a strong tendency toward perfectionism. A shared living space will generally be aesthetically pleasing to both of you. You benefit when you stay as aware as possible of your shared propensity for being fussy with each other and those around you, and learn to lean on your core values of balance and fairness.

Composite Mercury in Aries brings a forceful, impetuous and impulsive mentality to this relationship, and you are likely to take up new ideas with enthusiasm. You two tend to communicate in a way that is witty, inventive and quick, and impatient with opposition and delay. Your collective intuition is keen with a heightened sensitivity to sense impressions, either visual or auditory. You may have a tendency to exaggerate, or to argue with each other. This relationship has considerable mental energy, and you jointly have the need to assert yourselves in your thought process and your communication with each other and those around you. You benefit when you take this gift of quickness and learn to bring to it a greater degree of concentration and follow-through. With concentration, your abundant mental energy together becomes a real gift to all you encounter.

Composite Jupiter in Aries (13° Ari 38') **Composite Jupiter in the Seventh House**

Jupiter in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will find mutual good fortune and faith in positive outcomes.

Jupiter in the Seventh House (or sign) emphasizes the refined and idealistic aspects of your relationship. You two tend to experience the relationship itself as the true source of your shared happiness and this placement is one of the very best for romantic relationships. Together, you work well with other people, and may become known for your fairness. You each grow when you engage in these kinds of activities. You may form the type of partnership that will make a habit of championing both sides of a dispute and making sure that the underdog has his say. You may also be outwardly-directed as a partnership, and concerned with what others might think. In a romantic relationship, you are likely to find enjoyment everywhere together. Your relationship grows through exploring art and beauty wherever you may find it. You benefit when you develop your shared capacity to stop and smell the flowers and follow your energy to serve each other and the relationship, so that rather than pursuing the socially derived mandate to steam ahead, you allow your focus to be on simply getting your boat down the river.

Composite Jupiter in Aries (or the first house) indicates a relationship that is strong in self-esteem. You are expansive and abundant together, and are likely to have good luck with the material side of your lives. Your relationship to each other and with the world grows through your shared passion for freedom and independence, and also a penchant for fun and adventure. In a romantic context, a feeling of can-do is an important component of your self-image with each other. You are unusually fortunate in most things that you attempt, and possess a jovial sense of fun that makes your way easier along your shared road. You have an extremely optimistic nature as a duo. You two tend to see possibility in everything, jointly viewing the glass as half-full rather than half-empty. This is valuable, and takes you far in life. You benefit by making sure that the natural faith you have in your relationship's power remains grounded and focused on assessing practical steps in a sustainable way and when you temper your boundless enthusiasm with a healthy sense of limitation.

Composite Pluto in Virgo (25° Vir 23'R) **Composite Pluto in the Twelfth House**

Pluto in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter your mutual drive for power and which will be transformative for the relationship.

Pluto in the Twelfth House (or sign) can bring a powerful longing for transcendence into the relationship. With this placement, you may feel confined and limited in the physical world, perhaps

feeling more at home in a world of fantasy. You may desire to bring about changes in your life and feel yourselves unable to do so, at least while you are together. In a romantic connection, this depth of connection may enhance your intimate and sexual bond together. Or you may be so sensitive to each other's pain that you find it easier to retreat from each other than to truly honor your connection. There may be hidden currents of emotions between you to which you are quite sensitive, and as you explore the emotional power places deep within yourselves you have the capacity to help each other heal the residue of earlier traumas. You may be tempted to let go of the struggle at times into escapist behavior, but if you face the problems that need to be overcome between you, then you can balance your need for seclusion with a true desire for service to each other, and to your own evolutionary mandate. You may be able as a partnership to complete karmic obligations without continuing to feel like a victim. When you make an effort to move toward a more universal sense of self, you help each other learn to get out of your own way and allow for a more spiritually based outlook that takes into account each partner's individual needs as well as jointly.

Composite Pluto in Virgo (or the sixth house) correlates to a relationship where there is a need to sacrifice to the other and to the relationship. As a partnership, you may also experience a strong desire or even a compulsion to be of service to the general good or to others that you encounter. You may find you are working through very deep-seated unconscious dynamics of being truly helpful and available to others. In a romantic relationship, in order to prevent power struggles that inevitably play out within the issues of sharing and service to each other, it is important that you carefully turn the light of consciousness onto the working dynamics of the relationship. In spite perhaps of a culture that does not encourage it, you benefit when you develop an ability to mutually acknowledge the power dynamics at play, and to begin to cultivate a very real and sincere humility, or take the time to access built-up and unresolved emotions within you, and just let it be. It can be very helpful when you become aware of the compulsion to create crisis, and take time out from the relationship in order to practice deeply forgiving each other from this, and possibly other, lifetimes. You may have as a survival instinct for the relationship a mutual desire to bring integrity and expansion into the area of shared service and to confront any limitations within you that prevents this from happening. When you work together for greater individual consciousness in this area, you benefit not only yourselves but also others that you come into contact with, as you move toward a more conscious and freely given act of sharing.

Composite Chiron in Aries (3° Ari 40') **Composite Chiron in the Seventh House**

Chiron in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter patterns of wounds and deep connection and where eventual healing and empathy will occur.

Chiron in the Seventh House (or sign) indicates a relationship that provides you both with an opportunity to face and heal deeply held wounds regarding your ability to relate with each other and those around you intimately. With this placement, you share a tremendous desire to connect with other people, as well as a tremendous frustration that arises from your inability to do so. Your attempts to connect may have been frustrated through experiences of early childhood, when you each wanted contact with others but were rejected or somehow prevented from establishing meaningful relationships with them. As a consequence, you have focused on these connections ever since and perhaps created this relationship in an attempt to finally heal these wounds. It becomes extremely important to establish a connection with another person, yet this contact, so desired and even longed for, can also be extremely painful. Any partial rejection can cause you to have to revisit the original pain. As time goes on, you may notice you sabotage your relationship experiences. You may also become compulsively attached to the idea of close personal

involvement, valuing a desired union over your experience as an isolated ego, "on your own". Yet your very wholeness depends on your being able to stand independently. As you take advantage of this connection to become more fully conscious of the early wounding that you experienced, you can move through your pain toward a less fear-based way of relating, without recreating the self-undoing or the extreme sensitivity from before. You may also find that you can take the conscious knowledge you have gained through this process further by helping other people deal with these same issues. As you grow sure of yourselves, your wisdom with interpersonal relationships becomes a great source of strength for your relationship and for those around you as well.

Composite Chiron in Aries (or the First House) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity for the two of you to face and heal deeply held wounds with regard to your vital force to be and to initiate within the relationship. With this placement of Chiron, your very sense of the relationship may be threatened by disturbing realizations and painful memories. Together, you may work through pain that arose from feeling belittled and put down, rather than encouraged, by the significant adult figures around you in your formative years. Within this relationship you may encounter and overcome obstacles that prevent yourselves from reaching your full potential. You may find that in this relationship, you operate more from a fear of failing than from the expectation of success that would breed confidence for further achievement. You may find yourselves sacrificing your own goals to the goals of the other, or to those around you, because they seem somehow more important or at least deserving of priority treatment. Either one of you may feel a keen lack of achievement in your own life, and compensate by trying too hard to help others, putting yourself in the background. As long as these relationship patterns operate more or less unconsciously, they are difficult to overcome, so the first step in surmounting them is to become more conscious of what's going on inside. Become aware of your own pain. Acknowledge and discover more about what exactly went on in past relationships to make you both feel so resigned with your present abilities in this one. At that point you can begin to come out from behind your painful experiences and really show yourselves to each other and to the world around you. With a more conscious understanding of your own dynamics, you can begin to help others in how they deal with similar issues, transforming your false sense of vicarious achievement into a strong center of true friendship.

Composite N Node in Virgo (21° Vir 02') **Composite N Node in the Twelfth House**

Lunar North Node in the Twelfth House (or sign). South Node in the sixth house or sign. This placement in a composite chart signifies that within this relationship you each have an emphasis on spiritual rather than worldly concerns. Although the practical matters of everyday life come easily to you, you do not find your true happiness together in the pursuit of mundane affairs, but seek constantly to expand your horizons mentally and spiritually to a larger and more inclusive context. This may be difficult, for the pull of everyday life is very strong in you, and in many ways it is what you do best. In the past, you may have made much of refining your abilities in the practical world, dealing mainly with issues of personal health or of the welfare of others in small but important ways. Now, in this context of this relationship, your focus gradually shifts to a higher plane of activity. The two of you find your purpose not so much in day-to-day routine, but in sacrificing yourself to a higher *raison d'être*, to advancing beyond the material world, perhaps even manifesting a disregard for your own well being. By giving up personal ego-involvement in your actions, you are each learning how to relate to others around you with true compassion. You find yourself going deep within the wellsprings of your partnership to bring forth a renewed understanding of how to serve others, as you seek to become exemplars of a more spiritually based society,

Composite Lunar North Node in Virgo (or the sixth house). South Node in the twelfth house or sign. This placement in a composite chart indicates that within this relationship one or both of you feels a great desire to be of service to other people. There may be a sense that in the past, this partner remained relatively unfocused, perhaps was dreamy and paid little attention to detail. But this connection commends each of you to the here and now. Rather than drift in cosmic realms, in the context of this relationship your focus must shift to the details of daily life, in a constant effort to improve self, to serve self and other, and to remain alert to the myriad mundane details of life that do not leave much time for otherworldly pursuits. This is a difficult transition to make, but necessary if you are to fulfill your destiny, and to really explore to the depths your reason for being together. Other conditions may arise, such as illness on the part of one of you that will be a test of the other's patience and commitment to service. As you work through these challenges, though, you come closer and closer to an understanding of how dealing with every-day issues really does connect you with the world of Spirit, in a quite different way, still operating at the core of your being.

Other Aspects

Composite Mercury in strong opposition (within 3.0 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between composite Mercury and Uranus brings to your relationship an unusual communication style and mental acuteness, with a unique ability to grasp new concepts. As a partnership you enjoy the exploration of new ways of thinking and being, and are visionary in your shared outlook, intellectually straying far beyond conventional attitudes. This relationship undoubtedly provides restlessness and mental acuity, giving you an ability to think outside the box freely and grasp new concepts quickly. You benefit from developing discretion, so that you can tell the difference between the creatively possible and the clearly viable. Whether your relationship is personal or professional in nature, others value your ability to get to the core of an issue and find workable solutions quickly, although it helps you both to remain as aware as possible that the unpredictable and erratic quality of your shared thought processes may need translation in order for you to share your brilliance with others. You may also benefit from toning down your opinions at times, curbing a potential "know-it-all" attitude. You win when you bring discipline and persistence to the practical realization of your shared visions, which ultimately serve both the relationship and the larger world that surrounds you.

Composite Mercury in strong conjunction (within 3.1 degrees) with Chiron

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

With this aspect in your composite chart you may find that there is difficulty, and also great healing potential within your relationship, in the way that you express your ideas to each other. In the past, one or both of you may have had trauma in your background in connection with how you expressed yourself to your peers or siblings as a youngster. In the present, you may feel the residue of these painful early experiences, in terms of your ability to communicate effectively with those around you. It is likely that these same issues will come up in the context of this relationship for more conscious recognition and eventual healing. It may also be that you begin to detect

painful and difficult circumstances in the communication between the two of you as you get to know each other more completely. Of course it is always important to acknowledge your own feelings and possible wounding and reactivity first and foremost, rather than simply playing the "blame game" with each other. As you start to work things out, you begin to gain more conscious understanding of the ways in which you have been traumatized, and also unconsciously hurt others, in the past and on going. When you begin the process of transforming your painful experiences in this regard into clear pictures with greater acceptance less emotion attached to them, you'll discover the potential healing energy in your communication within the partnership, and for the way that you connect with others around you as well.

Composite Uranus in strong opposition (within 0.2 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect in your composite chart your relationship has a strong spiritual connection with it's own unique brand of philosophical outlook. As a partnership, you are likely to be prone to sudden insights and departures from consensus thinking. One or both of you probably has an unusual combination of personality traits in which you are very unconventional yet also somewhat unsure of yourself in your very departure from the rest of society, so that you may surprisingly show flashes of a conservative side. You are likely to have brilliant and refreshingly unconventional minds, and this combination of personality traits may have drawn you to each other in the first place. Now you can form a conspiracy of two that defeats the pressure to conform that constantly comes at you from the surrounding social setting. In this way, and with this very important support for each other, your relationship can be extraordinarily healing for you both, especially in the area of your own uncertainties regarding your resistance to the straight and narrow. You have a creative perspective that allows you to go far in pursuing your own unique brand of spirituality.

Composite Mercury in semi-sextile (within 3.0 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

With this aspect between composite Mercury and Saturn, your relationship has a responsible, centered and hard-working ideation process that also might be experienced as a blockage of communication between you. You share a profound mental connection. As a partnership, you may find that your thinking naturally deepens and concentrates when you are together. You have incredible perseverance in making your ideas known to each other and to the world around you, and could be just the team to take on an important writing project.

Composite Mercury in square (within 1.3 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

With this aspect between composite Mercury and the Midheaven, your relationship has a strong mental focus with the potential for heady conversation. You undoubtedly have a strong communication orientation in your relationship, and likely converse on many topics together. In a romantic relationship you may feel the need to balance your head with your heart. The excellent

communication that you share will compensate for many difficulties, but a strong emotional basis must also be an important component of your shared connection. As a team you have a terrific ability to reach out verbally to the world outside your partnership, either in spoken or written form, with a restless curiosity that touches on many subjects. You may enter into a joint writing project or encourage others to do the same. Leavening your wit and wisdom with an emotional depth and sharing it in that way with society around you gives you the best of both worlds.

Composite Mars in square (within 6.3 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Mars and Neptune brings to your relationship a strong idealism and psychic sensitivity together with an inclination to mysticism and the arts. As a duo you are drawn to the subtle and the ethereal. You may also experience a degree of confusion, so that you struggle to find the balance between the practical and the ideal. In a romantic connection, there may be powerful ideals of attraction between you, and your action and goal orientation within the partnership may border at times on deception or illusion. You may be able to fool yourselves into thinking you are doing the right thing when in fact you are blind to your true impulse. You benefit from keeping your communication very clear in order to achieve greater conscious awareness of your inner motivation. As a partnership you may question your own understanding of yourselves and the nature of your relationship. You benefit from clarifying your aims, and learning to focus your intention in order to become a channel for its higher use in your own life and the life of society around you.

Composite Mars in inconjunct (within 6.3 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

With this aspect between composite Mars and Pluto, your relationship has a passionate intensity and also the potential for conflict. There is a powerful connection between you based around the concept of self-assertion, either yours or your partner's, and one reason that you have come together at this time is to attempt to heal this issue in your lives. In a romantic connection, your sexual magnetism and activity is likely to be strong, as well as issues of power and control that are likely to crop up between you. The pattern of your relationship may be such that one of you appears timid or unsure to the other partner much of the time, since the power urge when problematic commonly hides deep underground, but there is the potential for sudden bursts of anger when repressed emotion finally finds its way to the surface. These issues will come up in the course of this relationship for the ultimate purpose of working them out and eventual healing. It is of course quite helpful when you both stay as conscious as you can regarding the underlying dynamic of your reactions. It profoundly benefits your relationship if you each can move away from blame and outbursts of resentment or rage, and instead tune into your inner process, or simply surrender to Spirit and the beyond. This simple act can make you feel a little more humble and a lot more whole.

Composite Saturn in inconjunct (within 2.1 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

This aspect brings an impractical, eccentric and future-oriented quality to your relationship. You two may find you rebel against authority, and with your strong imagination and good conceptual level, you probably have good reason to want to do things in new and different ways. When you function at your best you have the capability to bring a concrete and real-world practicality to the intangible and visionary Uranian energy. You benefit when you learn to move away from a knee-jerk reaction either for or against established authority, toward establishing your own personal authority, in your own way, and to help make your brilliant visionary impulses concrete and available to society at large.

**Composite Saturn in semi-sextile
(within 2.1 degrees) with Chiron**

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

With this aspect in your composite chart you are likely to be engaged in a relationship in which there is difficulty and also great healing potential around issues of authority. It may be that one or both of you have had painful experiences as a child, when you were forced to submit to an arbitrary authority or limitation of some kind. Perhaps you had the experience of a bad father. The relationship with your father was damaged in some way; it was something you had to get away from, either from his overbearing nature or from his neediness and lack of presence. These wounds can manifest in adult life as an attachment and also great difficulty with authority. For example you may endlessly achieve positions of authority and then have second thoughts about it. As you continually work through whatever arises in your daily interactions with each other, these types of issues may come up for acceptance and eventual healing. Since the powerful associated emotions may lie below the level of your ordinary awareness, your relationship connection may help to bring them to consciousness, and eventually acceptance. As a partnership, you may also wind up working these issues with others. You may be the ones to re-work the structure of society itself in some way, or to become advisors or leaders in the social sphere, perhaps in connection with organizations devoted to new age healing techniques. You may feel the need to redeem yourselves and your families; to restructure what you have internalized from your heritage. A better level of integration is possible, producing a more self-assured and balanced personality, independent from parental influences or even of those of society.

**Composite Saturn in sextile
(within 3.6 degrees) with Midheaven**

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This aspect between composite Saturn and the Midheaven brings solid recognition of the direction your relationship might take and a sense of mission regarding its purpose. As a partnership you are persistent and thorough, ambitious and clear-minded, with great staying power. In a romantic context, you may find that the issue of who is really in charge keeps cropping up. It may be that each of you holds some of the cards, and that you play them at different times, or in different ways. One partner may exhibit a strong sense of responsibility in the relationship, or you may alternate in this role. It is important to try to see the underlying motivation for your actions with regard to each other, and to strive for a better understanding of your partner's point of view. You may each have a deep urge for mastery and achievement which comes out even more so in connection with this partnership. You may run into difficulties, limitations or delays in reaching your goals, but you are

likely to come to success in the end through your tremendous drive.

**Composite Uranus in square
(within 0.2 degrees) with Midheaven**

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Uranus and the Midheaven brings to your relationship and its purposeful intention a sense of eccentricity and the unconventional. This relationship will be one that must go its own way, apart from the strictures of society or even whatever ideas that you each had before going into it. There may be some higher purpose that has brought you together, but it lies in wait for you to discover through time. In a romantic connection, you benefit when you do not seek to put any rules down for what you mean to each other. You will do better when you allow things to develop in their own way and give credit to your evolving mutual intuition of where the two of you are headed. Your joint ventures with each other carry a seed of going against the grain of consensus thinking.

**Composite Neptune in sextile
(within 3.3 degrees) with Pluto**

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This aspect between composite Neptune and Pluto is a generational aspect that many of your contemporaries will share, and indicates a relationship that is very attuned into the collective, both in its conscious and more unconscious aspects. You share a subtle intuition and unusually clear insight into others. Because the influence of the unconscious is especially strong in your relationship, it benefits you both to connect with your deepest, highest selves in order to be happy. You are part of a dawning awareness that we that cannot help but be part of creating a new paradigm for life on planet earth. You function at your best together when you are in service to the world, helping increase awareness of interconnectedness and oneness.

**Composite Chiron in square
(within 1.3 degrees) with Midheaven**

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Chiron and the Midheaven brings to your relationship a sense of your own woundedness and also a great potential for healing these wounds as you continue to work through them together. With this placement, there are likely to be issues from early childhood that may be triggered in the context of this relationship, perhaps around exerting personal will versus knuckling under to authority. If so, the evolutionary intent of bringing up these facets of the long-dead past is for moving through them and the eventual healing of these issues in your lives. When conflicts arise you benefit when you are able to look quietly and closely into your underlying motivations, rather than either attempting to ignore the pain that might be coming up for you or to put the blame on your partner for triggering your own reactivity. As a partnership you might also be called to a sense of mission around healing these types of problems in the lives of others.

**Composite Sun in weak trine
(within 0.2 degrees) with Neptune**

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

With this aspect between composite Sun and Neptune, your relationship has vision and creativity, with a high degree of sensitivity between you. You will find that your connection has an unworldly, ethereal side. You two tend to be spiritually aligned with similar dreams about how you want to live your life. Your connection may have a strong psychic, or nonverbal quality to it, and you are likely to share a deep passion for art, healing and the mystery. You two bring out a softhearted quality in each other, and you may have to be careful that you don't sacrifice too much of yourselves in helping others. Your relationship thrives in its subtle body, but you may begin to suffer if you expect it to bear fruit in the material plane. You may have difficulties with your motivation when together. There could be issues of idealism or fantasy, perhaps even outright deception that you will mutually work through in the course of this partnership. In a romantic relationship, you are likely to share an interest in art or music. When you do find expression for the mystical force you share between you, tremendous creativity is possible, perhaps manifested through artistic channels: music, drama, or poetry.

Composite Moon in weak trine (within 8.9 degrees) with Venus

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect between composite Moon and Venus brings a loving, calm and steady presence to your relationship, with a refined and artistic sensibility. You two go out of your way to please and accommodate each other and tend to take special care of each other's feelings. You are habitually cheerful in each other's company and likely feel yourselves to be engaged in a spiritual romance, no matter what kind of relationship you share. You may make better dreamers than doers, but that shouldn't stand in your way; since you travel far on your good vibes alone. This is a wonderful aspect for a romantic connection, and also serves well for parents or for professional colleagues working in an artistic environment. The love between you makes it easy to forgive and forget, and can smooth out other difficulties. Together, you possess a great deal of personal charm, and also have a love for the arts, especially music and dance. You tend to be courteous and popular as a couple, and you go out of your way to be supportive to friends.

Composite Moon in weak conjunction (within 8.9 degrees) with Mars

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction between composite Moon and Mars brings a powerful emotional and potentially argumentative presence to your connection with each other. You two tend to experience a sometimes difficult and at other times harmonious give and take, meeting each other in profound and penetrating ways. Although kind and benevolent in your intentions, you may behave with a great deal of intensity toward one another, and in a romantic relationship there can be extremes of anger and love, as well as physical pleasure. You can be fierce and fiery with each other in one moment, and passionate and poetic in the next. You tend to think deeply together, but you may find yourselves intolerant if you suspect that the other partner is somehow not taking your feelings into account. You may as a unit experience a restless, nervous tension, and it benefits you to engage in constructive activity together as an outlet. If you find yourselves saying things before you think them through, it may be best to remember to exercise a modicum of control over emotional outbursts. It's never a good idea to completely hold back your feelings however, since they will eventually find an outlet with even greater extremity. In this relationship, it bodes well to

cultivate a regular practice of forgiveness so you can easily move through impulsive disagreement and back into passionate playfulness.

Composite Mercury in weak trine (within 3.0 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect between composite Mercury and Neptune indicates a clever and imaginative relationship that exudes a subtle charm. You tend to communicate with each other in visionary and poetic ways, and together you can express the normally inexpressible. Your conversations are likely to be inspired, with a deep appreciation of the arts, the imagination and the mystery, although there is also at least the potential for deceptive illusion between you. In a romantic relationship the danger is also that with such a strong connection between your conscious and unconscious minds, your shared sensitivity runs so high that engaging in other activities, even sexuality, can feel like coming down. You also might need to take care to more clearly discriminate between fantasy and reality, in order to avoid overly glamorizing each other or another focus of your shared idealizing. You can mutually profit from learning to clearly channel the truth that arises out of your joint thought process, being careful to discriminate the ideal and the sensible in day-to-day mundane issues. Then you can allow yourselves to reap the full benefit and inspiration of this placement without suffering unnecessarily from bumping up against the reality of practical concerns.

Composite Venus in weak opposition (within 5.1 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between composite Venus and Saturn brings a potential blockage to your relationship, as well as a deepening and a concentration of your powers. With this placement you may notice you don't get what you want from your partner. You may feel as though you were working at cross-purposes with each other. Especially in a romantic relationship, obstacles to do with distance, age, lack of availability or the like, tend to crop up on your joint path, making it difficult for you get to where you want to go with each other. Even in a business-oriented partnership, these types of issues may present problems and keep you from ever feeling as though you were truly on the same page with each other. You may seem cold or uncaring to each other at times, or express jealousy or other feelings of inferiority, which may also manifest as a nagging discontent with life in general, and this of course causes difficulty in the relationship. Together, you have an opportunity to rise above these circumstances with concentrated effort over time toward inner integration and balance, building a relationship more fully explored and felt.

Composite Neptune in weak trine (within 3.3 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

With this aspect in your composite chart you have in your relationship a strong spiritual connection and an almost psychic sympathy with each other, based on your own experiences in these sensitive areas. One or both of you is likely to have particularly strong access to the world of dreams and inner fantasy, which may serve as an escape valve. If so, there may be a wound to your sense of place in this physical world. You may be extremely sensitive to the energy of others,

and vicariously experience their pain, or allow yourself to be overly influenced by their opinion of you. Something perhaps keeps you out of touch with consensus reality, and you are not very comfortable with this role. It is as if you stand on the other side of a glass door from the rest of society, through which you alternately gaze longingly and then lose interest and wander away into your own fantasy. Your spiritual evolution involves moving through this issue, and there is a way that this relationship will be an important steppingstone for both of the partners in this regard. There may also be issues to work through regarding too much idealism or self-sacrifice by one of you. Once you have begun to work through these difficulties and establish a better sense of where you each stand vis a vis the remainder of society, the two of you are capable of tremendous spiritual powers. Together you may build bridges from this world to the visionary other, exhibiting great poetic or musical talent or the empathy of the born healer. Having come through a painful examination of your own psyche you are able to see more clearly and compassionately into the minds of others around you as well.

Glossary

Ascendant: The point in the sky of the Eastern horizon. In the chart, the Ascendant is represented by the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart which crosses between the Twelfth and First Houses. The sign on the Ascendant is also referred to as the Rising Sign.

Aspects: When the relative positions of two planets in the horoscope form a significant angle with each other, they are said to be in aspect with one another. The type and quality of the aspect is determined by the number of degrees between the two planets and is only considered significant if it is within a narrow range of degrees, or orb. A list of the aspects used in this report is given below.

Conjunction — $0^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Opposition — $180^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Trine — $120^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Square — $90^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Sextile — $60^{\circ} \pm 6$ degrees

Inconjunct — $150^{\circ} \pm 4$ degrees

Chart Comparison: An astrological technique in which the planets of two individuals are shown in a bi-wheel chart, one within the other. This allows the inter-aspects between the two charts to be examined.

Composite Chart: An astrological technique in which the midpoints of two individuals' planetary positions are used to create a third chart, the composite chart, which is then interpreted as the chart of the relationship itself as an independent entity.

Horoscope: Originally horoscope referred to the astrological chart itself, but is now popularly used to refer to the description of how current planetary positions are affecting you personally, as in "your monthly horoscope."

Midheaven: The point in the sky directly overhead relative to the position on Earth. In the chart, the Midheaven is represented by the vertical line at the top of the chart between the Ninth and Tenth Houses.

Natal: From Latin, meaning of or pertaining to birth; therefore your birth chart, or planetary positions at birth.

Nodes: The Lunar Nodes are the two points where the Moon's orbital path crosses the plane of the

ecliptic (the plane of the Earth's orbit around the Sun). Symbolically they represent talents and life path, or destiny.

Planets: In astrology, the word planets is used to describe astrologically significant points in the sky which includes the Sun and Moon, as well as many objects that are not currently astronomically defined as planets such as Chiron and Pluto.

Transits: Aspects formed between the current positions of the planets and the positions of your natal planets at the time and place you were born.
